



2009 Achievement Awards

Objective

To recognize individuals for outstanding accomplishment within one of the functional fields of comptrollership.

Award Criteria

Any military or civilian person(s), currently employed by the Department of Defense (to include National Guard & Reserve Components) or the United States Coast Guard may be nominated. A member or non-member of ASMC may be nominated. Individual contractors can only be nominated for an award in the individual category of Contractor Support.

Award Categories

Awards will be selected for the following categories:

- Accounting and Finance
- Analysis and Evaluations
- Auditing
- Budgeting
- Business Management/Acquisition
- Contractor Support
- Comptroller/Deputy Comptroller Support
- Education and Training Development
- Intern/Trainee
- Resource Management
- Team Achievement

Submission Requirements

Any office or person in the Department of Defense or the United States Coast Guard (to include National Guard or Reserve Components) may nominate a person who has demonstrated outstanding performance. Each nomination must be prepared on the 2009 ASMC Washington Chapter Annual Awards Submission Template. The justification must be limited to two pages to include nominee and nominator information. If an individual is nominated in more than one category, prepare a separate entry for each category.

Award Selection Procedures

Judging will be based on outstanding performance as evidenced by documentation of:

- Impact: (50% weighted) Focused on the impact the implementation of the accomplishment had across the organization and/or functional communities.
- Complexity and Leadership: (35% weighted) Focused on how difficult it was to develop and implement the effort and what specific leadership skills were demonstrated.
- Resource Savings: (15% weighted) Focused on the monetary and/or non-monetary savings; manpower, process improvement, time, year of execution savings, projected savings etc

A selection panel, chaired by a national officer from the Service in which the nomination was received, will review all submissions and make final recommendations to the National Executive Committee, who will approve the final award winners. Winners will be notified by May 1.

Deadline

Nominations **must** be submitted to Lt Col Steven Minkin via email by January 22 (email address listed below) to be considered by the selection panel. Nominating officials for Chapter winners will be notified to submit their nominees for National consideration by the 27th of January. Submissions for National consideration are due by the 31st of January via the ASMC Awards OnLine website.

Recognition

Awards will be presented at the ASMC Regional Professional Development Institute (RPDI) and winners will be listed on the website. Nominating officials should encourage all superiors of organizations that have winning candidates to have those candidates present at the annual RPDI to receive awards.
